RULES AND REGULATIONS

Halter, Western, English championship classes are invite classes only – horse must win 1st or 2nd place in a reg. halter western or English class to participate – will not be charged for halter championship class

All 2 gait and 3 gait classes are Breed specific gait classes or walk/trot or walk/trot/canter
It is the judge's discretion for the championship classes

Proper Class and /or breed specific tack and attire to be worn by exhibitors. Wearing a helmet in the show classes is optional

All participants in the Speed events will be required to wear a helmet.

No adding a class at the gate - to add a class person must come to the booth and pay or notify the registration clerk two classes ahead of time to be added.

No one under the age of 18 is allowed to show a stallion

All other rules and regulations will be at the judge's discretion and based off breed specific regulations, and rules and 4-H guidelines.
